PARADE - CHELMSFORD MA

5 July 2010

The Regiment shall form on Monday, 5 July to parade through the town of Chelmsford, Massachusetts with bayonets fixed, drums beating and colours flying. This is a paid event and attendance is expected from all. There will be a group photo taken prior to boarding shuttle busses in the morning, so arrive with weapons and brass bright.

Uniform is #2 Dress (natural colour wigs). There will be no firing. Flints are to be replaced by woods. Line and Staff officers to wear shoes with gaiters, mounted officers in boots. Please note that the Paymaster will be collecting donations for the Eva Morrissey education fund.

Schedule:

- 0730 hrs: Arrival at the Chelmsford Town Hall, 50 Billerica Road (Route 129) in Chelmsford. The Town Hall is a brick building on the north side of the road, just east of the intersection of 129 with Routes 4 and 110. Park in the lot next to the Town Hall, or by the playing fields behind the Town Hall.
- 0800 hrs: Assembly, brief inspection and group photo
- 0830 hrs: Board shuttle busses for the McCarthy Middle School
- 0900 hrs: Arrive at McCarthy Middle School
- 1000 hrs: Parade steps off. The route along North Road (Route 4) to Chelmsford Center, ending on Chelmsford Street.
- 1200 (about): Dismissal and return to vehicles at the Town Hall.

All participants are invited after the parade to the home of Captain Lincoln Clark at 54 Westford Street, Chelmsford (about 1 mile from the Town Hall) after the parade for roast beef sandwiches, lemonade and, if you've been very good, strawberry shortcake.
