EXETER NEW HAMPSHIRE FESTIVAL

17 July 2010

The Regiment will appear, under command of Lieutenant Colonel O'Shaughnessy, on Saturday 17 July at the one-day American Independence Festival in Exeter NH. Uniform is #1. Weapons equipped with flints and hammer stalls. Bring both caps and hats.

This is a paid appearance and your attendance is expected.

Canvas is needed. If you have a wedge tent, please bring it to set up for the day at our encampments site in Exeter.

Schedule:

- 0900 – Arrival and setup in Swazey Park, Exeter NH
- 0945 – First assembly and inspection of troops by NCOs
- 1000 – Festival opens.
- 1015 – Assemble to march by platoons to Water Street.
- 1030 – Reading of the Declaration of Independence on Water Street. Loud heckling is encouraged.
- 1100 – The Loyalist Point of View presented at Folsom Tavern, Water Street. Companies will drill for the public.
- 1200 – Dismissal for lunch. Watermelon provided by Loyal Farmer Rich Kaskeski.
- 1330 – Assembly, arms inspection and distribution of powder.
- 1400 – Skirmish with Militia on Swazey Park.
- 1600 – The Loyalist Point of View presented at Folsom Tavern, Water Street. Companies will drill for the public.
- 1700 – Festival closes, dismissal and break down camp.

Members are encouraged to interact with the public, argue the Cause of His Majesty, and recruit any and all willing to stand up for Loyalty and against Sedition.

All are welcome to attend an after-event collation at the home of Chaplain Williams, 129 Walnut Avenue, North Hampton NH. He may don his robes and lecture one and all upon The Evils of Drink.

Directions:

- Parking is at a public lot next to Swazey Park. The entrance appears on Google Maps at 253 Water Street, Exeter NH.
- From Nashua, Manchester NH and points north: Take NH Route 101 east to exit 10, NH 85 south towards Exeter. Follow Route 85 south for approximately 1.5 miles. The parking lot is on the left immediately before the intersection with Main Street.
- From Massachusetts and points south: Take Route 95 north to exit 2 onto NH 101 west. Take exit 10 onto NH 85 south towards Exeter, as described above.
- Swazey Park is accessible through the rear of the parking lot
