ST. PATRICK'S / EVACUATION DAY PARADE, BOSTON, MA

17 March 2024

The Regiment shall form under the Command of Lt. Colonel Michael Graves on Sunday, 17 March to parade through South Boston with drums beating, bayonets fixed and Colours flying in commemoration of *Saint Patrick's Day and Evacuation Day*.

Uniform shall be Modified No 2 Dress... company caps, natural wigs, wool leggings, canteens, and no haversacks. There will be no firing thus flints are to be replaced by woods. In case of cold weather, uniformed soldiers are allowed to wear period-appropriate gloves (check with your CO'Y NCO as to what is acceptable). Civilians, in 18th century attire, are welcome to participate.

Travel is by private vehicle; carpooling is recommended. Participant drop-off and parking will be at **541 Dorchester Ave, South Boston, MA 02120**. After checking in, a shuttle will be available to take participants to our assembly area **45 Binford St. Boston, MA** (Gate #5 of the Gillette World HQ Parking Lot). We are in Division 3. 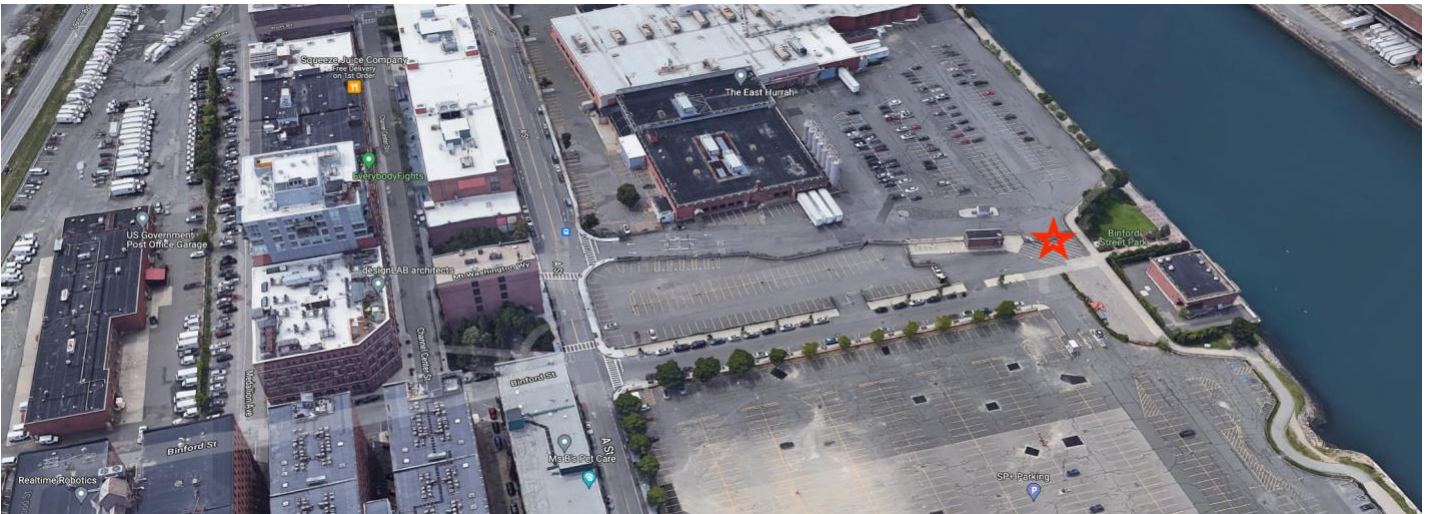
PARTICIPANT PARKING LOCATION:

After being dropped off by the shuttle bus, each participant will proceed to their designated staging area.

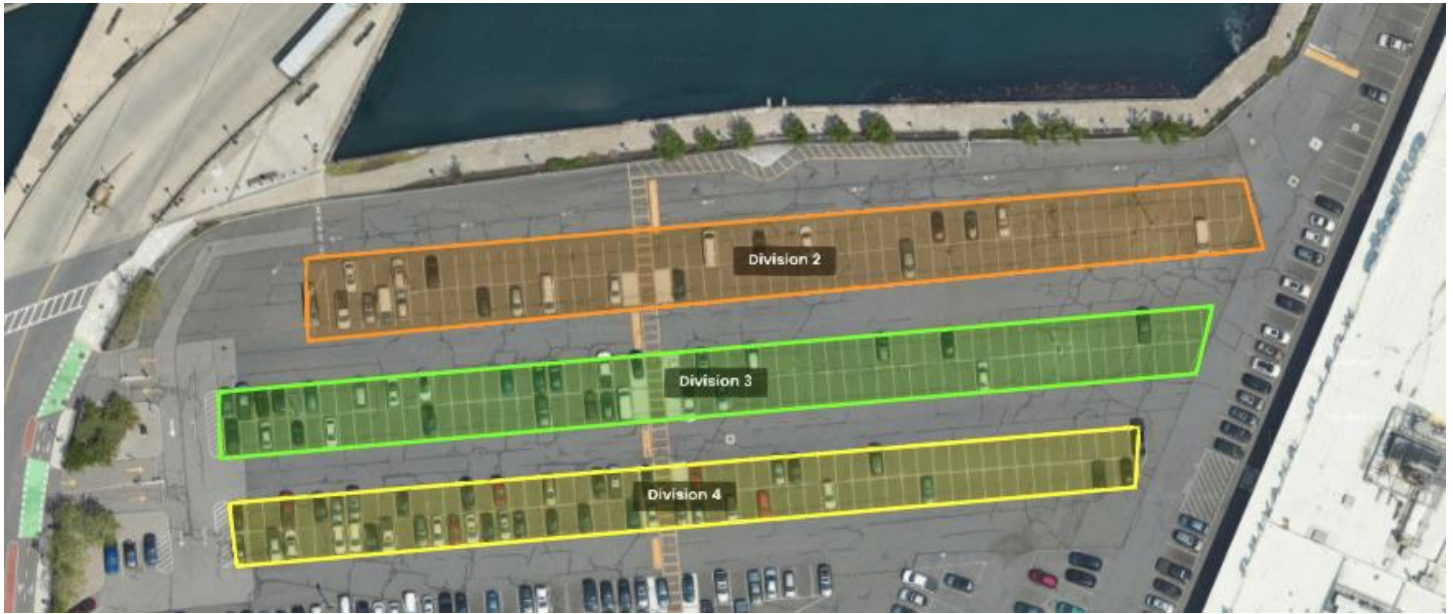
PARADE STAGING ENTRANCE:



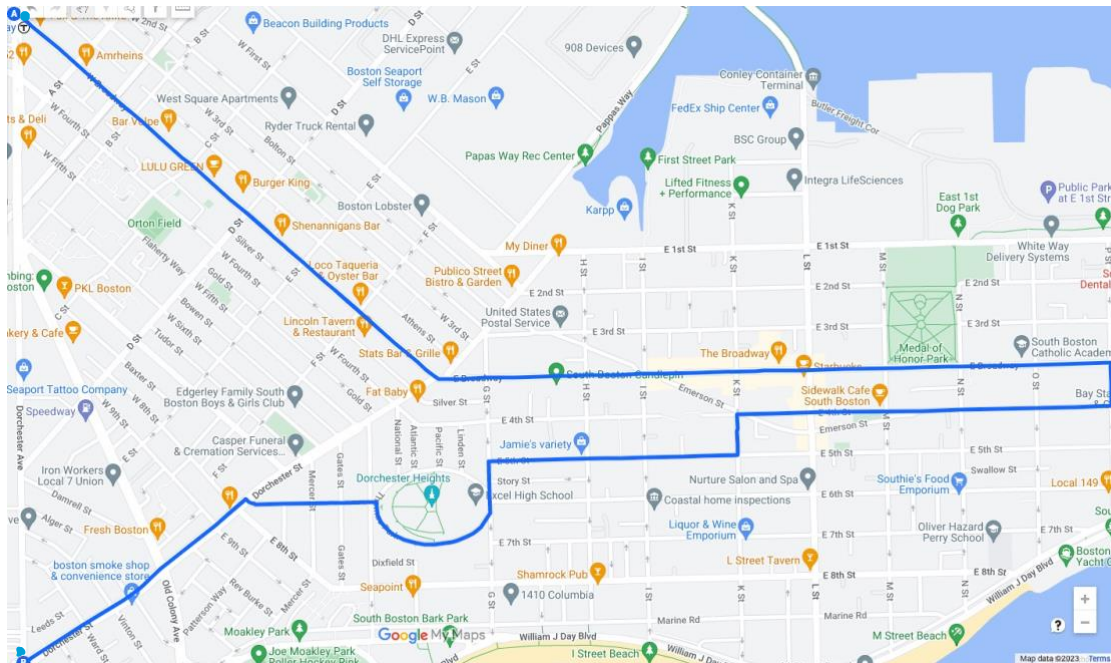
The star denotes GATE 5 to enter Gillette World HQ Parking Lot **GPS Address: 45 Binford St, Boston MA**
