The Regiment will appear under the command of Lieut-Col Michael Graves for the **Battle Road Muster** scheduled for Saturday 30 March 2024. This event will be our last chance to inspect uniforms and kit for final corrections before the Lexington Green rehearsal. Note that the Park Service considers this as “required” for all those wishing to appear in park events over Patriot’s Day weekend, and thus also is required for members of the 10<sup>th</sup>.

There are two locations for this event; the MMNHP Visitor Center, for members of our Civilian Corps who will be serving as Guides or Evacuees, and Hartwell Tavern, for our uniformed members. Travel is by private vehicle. Car-pooling is **HIGHLY** recommended. Parking in the morning will be at the Visitor Center lot, 210 North Great Road, Lincoln MA, or the Hartwell Tavern lot, 112 North Great Road, Lincoln MA. Note that Great Road also is known as Route 2A.



In the afternoon, we will travel to 280 Monument St, Concord, MA to rehearse the North Bridge scenario.

For uniformed soldiers, dress shall be No. 2: wool small clothes, natural wigs, short gaiters for all ranks (Officers may wear boots in lieu of shoes and gaiters), and haversacks to be worn over belting. All firelocks are to be equipped with woods, flash guards and hammerstalls. There will be no firing, but National Parks representatives will be inspecting all troops for proper equipment. Civilian attire should be appropriate according to the Park's requirements. The event will last for 6 hours so canteens should be filled with water, and everyone may want to carry a snack or lunch.
