LEXINGTON GREEN * CONCORD NORTH BRIDGE CEREMONY AND PARADE * LEXINGTON PARADE

15 April 2024

The Regiment will appear under the command of Lieut-Col Michael Graves for the Battle at Lexington Green, Lexington, Massachusetts, the North Bridge Ceremony and Concord Parade, Concord, Massachusetts, then the Lexington Parade, Lexington, Massachusetts, on Monday 15 April 2024.

Dress for uniformed soldiers shall be No. 2 for all ranks: wool small clothes, short gaiters, natural wigs, canteens filled with water, haversacks on top of belting. Officers may wear shoes and gaiters in lieu of boots. All firelocks are to be equipped with flints, flash guards and hammerstalls as there will be firing.

Schedule for the day

03:00-04:15 hrs: Arrive at the parking lot behind Lexington Depot at 13 Depot Square. There will be designated reenactor parking on the East side of the lot (turn right as you enter the lot). This parking lot may fill up quickly. It is strongly recommended that you arrive well within this time frame!

Make your way to the Masonic Lodge at 3 Bedford Street where the Lexington Minutemen will have their usual coffee and donuts for us. To avoid the public, make your way across the parking lot, across Meriam Street, and cut through the parking lot of Church of the Redeemer.

04:30 hrs: Following the Map (next page), you will make your way on foot along the bike trail to the Lexington Town Offices, which are just beyond the Post Office (Note that this is just beyond where we park). ***Be mindful of your "voice volume" as you are walking through neighborhoods early in the morning!***

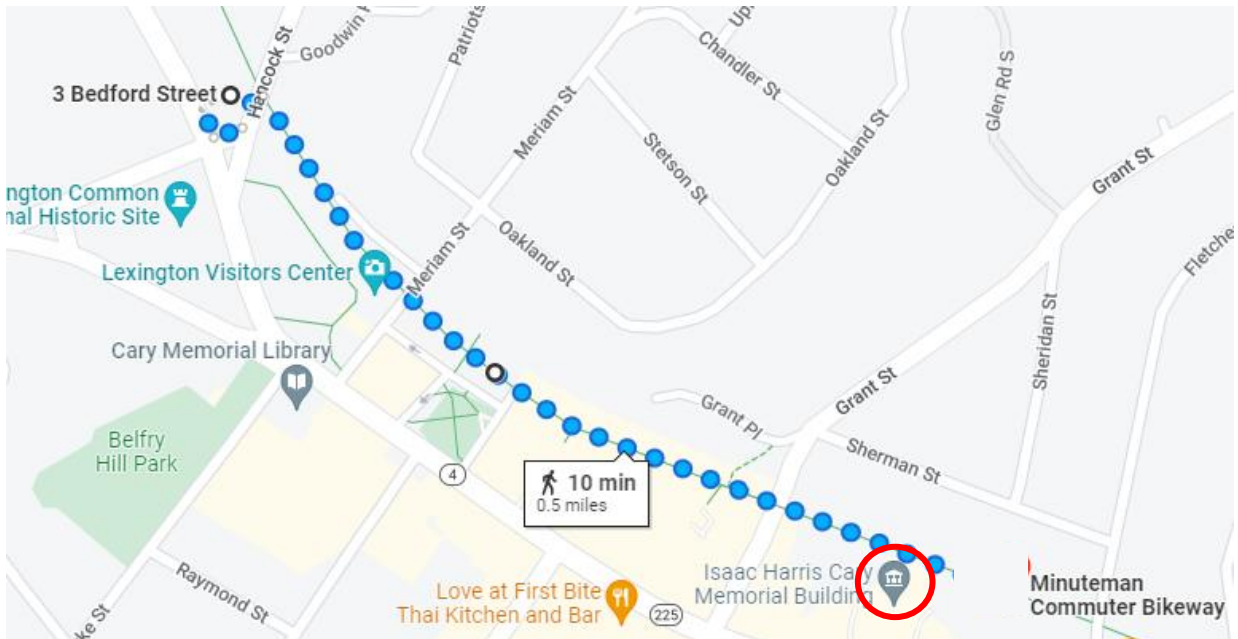
05:00 hrs: The Regiment shall assemble in the Town Offices parking lot for formation, inspection and distribution of powder.

05:50 hrs: The Regiment shall march off to Lexington Green.

06:30 hrs: Dismissal near St. Brigid's. The Regiment will be available for recruiting and interacting with the public. A pancake breakfast sponsored by the Boy Scouts will be available at St. Brigid's.

07:30 hrs: The Regiment shall depart for St. Bernard's Church parking lot in Concord

Center. Car-pooling should be arranged before departure.

- 08:00 hrs:** The Regiment shall form at St. Bernard's parking lot, 12 Monument Square, Concord, and march to North Bridge to participate in the ceremonies there.
- 08:30 hrs:** Arrival at Monument Street parking area for inspection and ammunition distribution
- 08:45 hrs:** Crown Forces occupy North Bridge
- 09:00 hrs:** North Bridge Scenario begins
- 09:15 hrs:** Crown Forces and Provincial forces assemble on North Bridge for combined salute followed by Mourn Arms ceremony in front of the British soldiers' graves.
- 09:30 hrs:** The Regiment returns to parking area for collection of powder and joins the Concord Parade ending on Stow Street, Concord.
- 11:00 hrs:** Return to St. Bernard's parking lot for dismissal to return to Lexington.
- 11:45 hrs:** Arrive at the Lexington High School Parking lot 251 Waltham St. ***Lunch to be provided by the Regiment.***
- 12:45 hrs:** The Regiment embark on buses and travels to the start of the Lexington Parade. Note the buses run from the school parking lot to the parade start from 11:45 hrs – 13:30 hrs.
- 14:00 hrs:** Lexington Parade steps-off
- 15:30 hrs:** Approximate time of dismissal at the high school lot post parade.

Note that this is a long day with much going on and the above schedule will be “fluid.” Thus, we ask all members to remember our Regimental motto “*Be flexible!*” and act accordingly.

The Regiment needs at or near 100% attendance for all scheduled events for this day as this is our season premiere, which includes two of our five paid parades. Should you not be able to attend, or if you have questions about this order, contact your Company Serjeant as soon as possible.
