ST. PATRICK'S / EVACUATION DAY PARADE, BOSTON, MA

16 March 2025

The Regiment shall form under the Command of Lt. Colonel Michael Graves on Sunday, 16 March to parade through South Boston with drums beating, bayonets fixed and Colours flying in commemoration of *Saint Patrick's Day and Evacuation Day*.

Uniform shall be Modified No 2 Dress... company caps, natural wigs, wool leggings, canteens, and no haversacks. There will be no firing thus flints are to be replaced by woods. In case of cold weather, uniformed soldiers are allowed to wear period-appropriate gloves (check with your CO'Y NCO as to what is acceptable). Civilians, in 18th century attire, are welcome to participate.

Travel is by private vehicle; carpooling is encouraged as parking can be tight. Participant drop-off and parking will be at **541 Dorchester Ave, South Boston, MA 02120**. After checking in, a shuttle will be available to take participants to our assembly area **94 A St. Boston, MA**. We are in Division 1. See pages 2-4 for complete parade information, including maps.

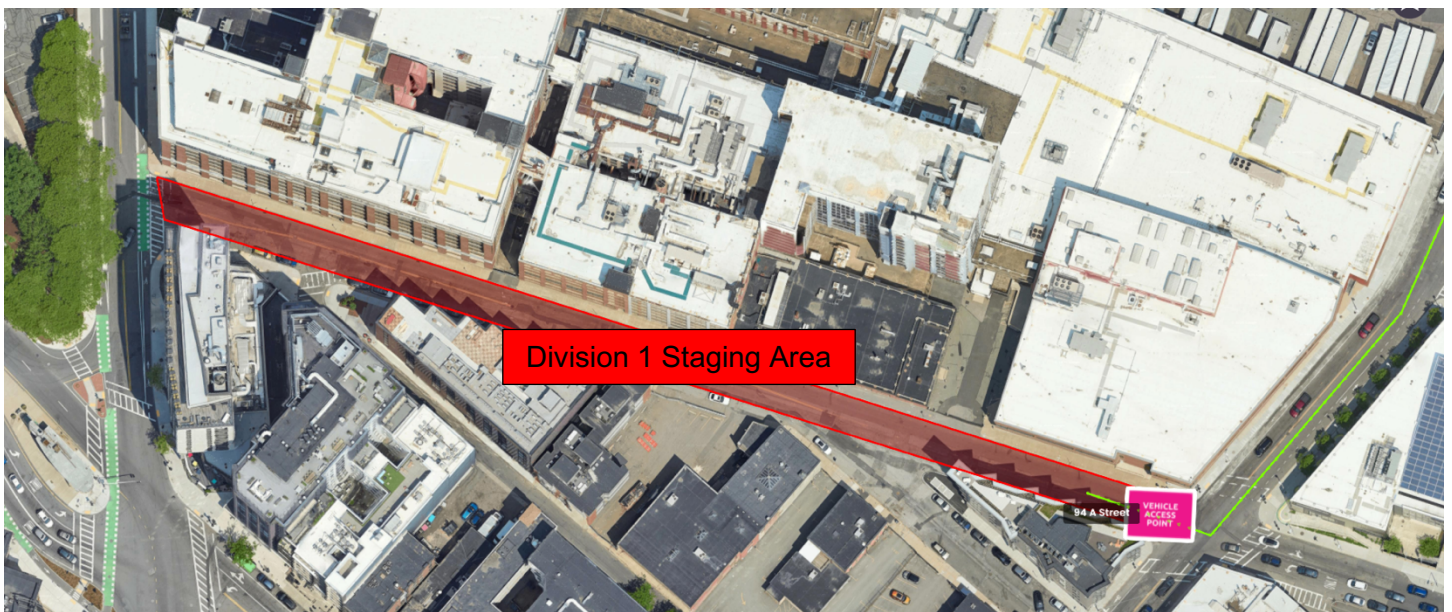
PARTICIPANT PARKING LOCATION:



PARKING DETAILS: Non-vehicle participants should go to **541 Dorchester Ave, South Boston, MA 02120** to park their cars. After checking in, they will receive shuttle bus service to the Gillette World Headquarters.

After being dropped off by the shuttle bus, each participant will proceed to their designated staging area.

PARADE VEHICLE STAGING ENTRANCE:

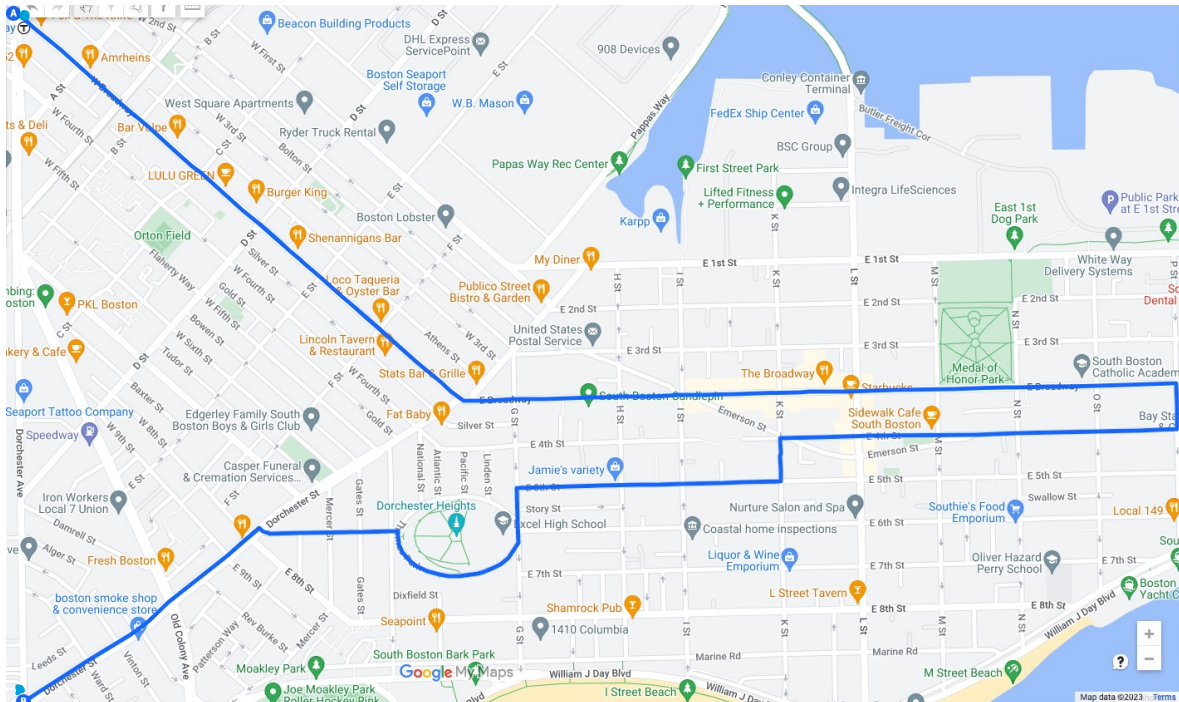


If your vehicle is part of your Parade Unit, please use the GPS address **94 A St, Boston, MA 02127** to enter the staging area, making sure your vehicle is facing the correct direction. When you arrive, Parade staff will greet you and assist in ensuring you are in the right place. All pedestrian participants will head from the shuttle bus drop-off area at Gillette HQ to their designated staging area on West Second Street.
