BATTLE OF GLOUCESTER

19 – 21 JUNE

The Regiment will appear under the command of Lieutenant Colonel Michael Graves for the 251st Anniversary of the *Battle of Gloucester* encampment weekend at Stage Fort Park in Gloucester, MA on Friday 20 June through Sunday 22 June. Uniform is No. 2 (company uniforms with haversacks, canteens, and short gaiters). Since there will be firing, muskets must be equipped with flints and hammerstalls. Line and Staff officers may wear shoes with gaiters in lieu of boots. Companies should bring caps, hats, and forage caps. Military courtesies and correct 18th Century attire, free of anachronisms, are expected during all public hours.

Travel is by private vehicle; carpooling is encouraged. Stage Fort Park is located at *24 Hough Ave, Gloucester, MA*. The most direct way to get there is to follow Rte 128 Northbound until 133 E/Essex Ave (exit 53) and at the end take a right onto Western Ave. This is a Friday in the summer, so try to avoid coming through downtown Gloucester as there is a draw bridge for boats that holds up traffic.

A map of Stage Fort Park showing each area is provided on page 3. Additionally, a release form to print and sign is provided on page 6.

There are three areas for parking: Stage Fort Park, Tally's Farm, and Gloucester High School. You will be directed to the appropriate lot after you unload your equipment. Shuttle service will be provided for the off-site lots. Further parking information can be found on pages 4 and 5. See below for shuttle schedule.

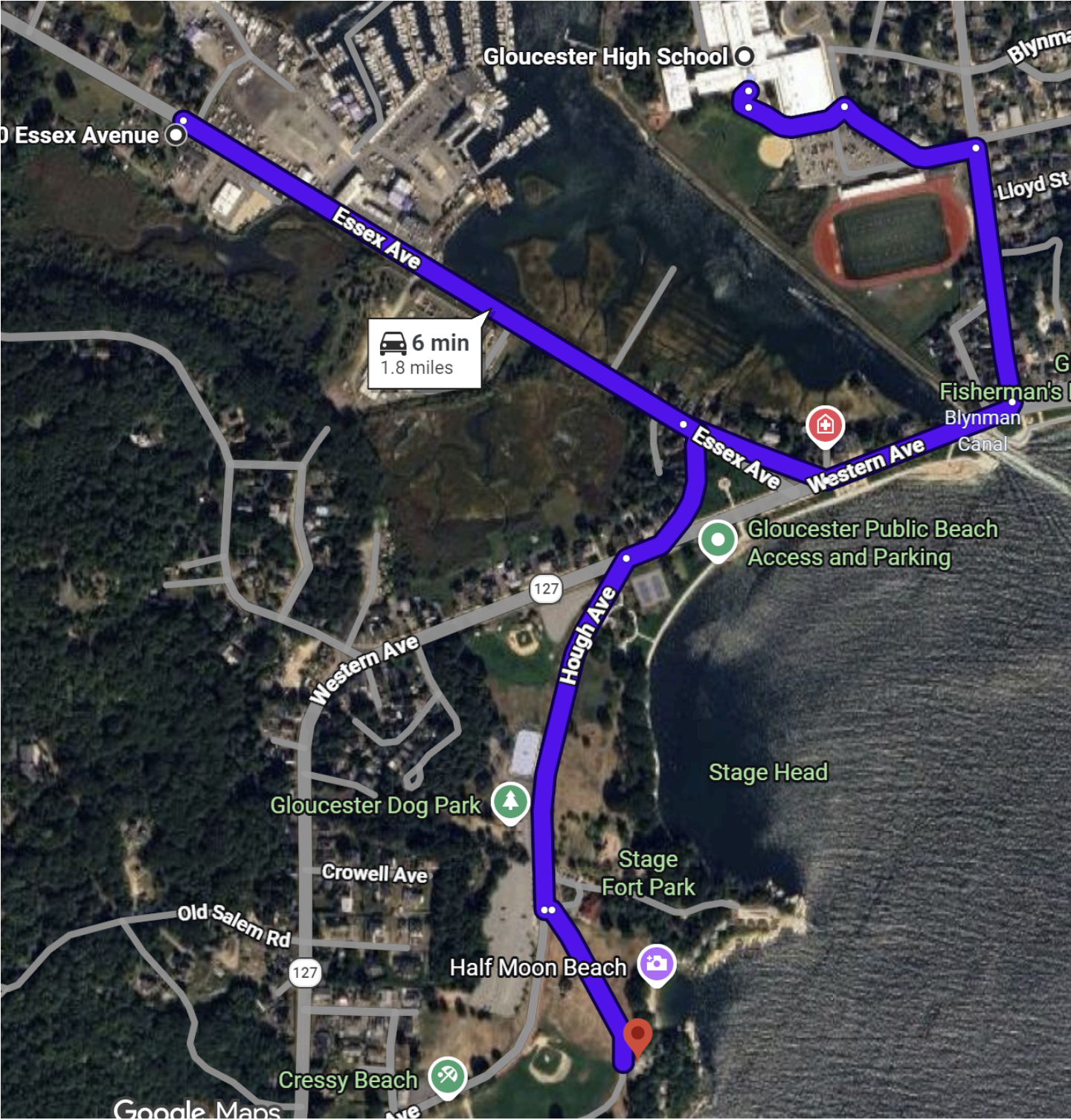


Blue - Little League field - NO PARKING
