The Regiment will appear under the command of Lieutenant Colonel Michael Graves for our return to Old Sturbridge Village for *Redcoats and Rebels* Saturday August 1st.

Uniform is No. 2. Since there will be firing, muskets must be equipped with flints and hammerstalls. Companies should bring caps, hats, and forage caps. Military courtesies and correct 18th Century attire, free of anachronisms, are expected during all public hours.

Travel is by private vehicle; carpooling is encouraged. The village's address is 1 Old Sturbridge Village Rd, Sturbridge, MA.

Arrivals on Saturday are between 06:30 hrs and 09:00 hrs.

There will be a roster at the registration table that Major Potter submitted for the Tenth. ***All members need to submit a release form at registration. For our members under the age of 18, a parent/guardian will need to sign the form.***

Parking is on site in a designated area and all parked vehicles must display a parking pass, which will be available at registration.
