FORT at NO. 4

11 - 13 SEPTEMBER

The Regiment will appear under the command of Lieutenant Colonel Michael Graves for the *Return to Number 4: Revolutionary War Encampment Weekend*, Fort at No. 4 in Charlestown, New Hampshire, on Saturday 12 September through Sunday 13 September.

Uniform is No. 2. Since there will be firing, muskets must be equipped with flints and hammerstalls. Line and Staff officers to wear shoes with gaiters or boots. Companies should bring caps, hats, and forage caps. Military courtesies and correct 18th Century attire, free of anachronisms, are expected during all public hours.

Travel is by private vehicle; carpooling is encouraged. The fort's address is: *267 Springfield Road (NH Route 11), Charlestown, NH.*
