BATTLE OF FAIRHOLM FARM

10 – 12 OCTOBER

The Regiment will appear under the command of Lieutenant Colonel Michael Graves for the *Battle of Fairholm Farm* in Woodstock, CT on Friday 10 October through Sunday 12 October.

Uniform is No. 2. Since there will be firing, muskets must be equipped with flints and hammerstalls. Line and Staff officers to wear shoes with gaiters or boots. Companies should bring caps, hats, and forage caps. Military courtesies and correct 18th Century attire, free of anachronisms, are expected during all public hours.

Travel is by private vehicle; carpooling is encouraged. The farm's address is: *80 Chandler School Road, Woodstock, CT*. The camp is on the north side of the road just East of the address above. Signs will be posted. Parking will be beyond the rear of the camp.
