Meeting called to order: 7:04PM

- I. Opening Remarks: Michael Graves began the meeting going over the NPS association. It appears that MMNHP wants to have their own reenactment group, like at Fort Ticonderoga. We should treat the association as a reenacting group and our members can't be a part of conflicting groups, so we should tell our members that they can't be a part of both. On the application for the association, MMNHP specifies a 5th Regiment Light Infantry kit, so are they trying to form their own company, and the association requires members to commit to one event per year, or more if a kit is loaned.

The group discussed obtaining more information from Jim Hollister and the future of the Regiment's partnership with MMNHP. For 2026, Battle Road will be a much more limited event. Michael Graves feels that Command Staff should take a more stringent approach to the association since information is not widely distributed. Being cautious now will be easier to adjust to a more lenient approach than having to limit members in the future if they join the association now.
